KEY SELECTION CRITERIA

POSITION: Psychologist/Student Counsellor

1. Demonstrates a strong understanding of, and commitment, to Catholic education.
2. Demonstrates an understanding and acceptance of the St Mary MacKillop College Vision and Mission Statement and the values that underpin it.
3. A Degree in Psychology or equivalent Degree in Social Work/Counselling.
4. Demonstrates ability in counselling which reflects current therapeutic practices in working with students and their families, who may come from a variety of backgrounds, particularly those with diverse learning needs.
5. Prior experience in working with adolescents and ability to build rapport.
6. Able to demonstrate a high level of understanding of the position responsibilities.
7. Able to gain and keep successful registration for a Working with Children Check and successfully passing a National Police Record History Check.
8. Expertise in using computer databases, the internet, email navigation and Microsoft Office and Google Suites.

APPLICANTS are required to submit the following:

1. Introductory letter briefly outlining their suitability and interest in the position.
2. A fully completed application form, including contact details for referees.
3. A statement addressing the key selection criteria outlined above.
4. Certified copies of qualifications including academic transcripts.
5. Certified copy of evidence of VIT Registration or Working with Children Check and National Police Record Check for non-teaching staff.
